## System Entry Skills Testing Outline

1. Airway management of the adult, child and infant
  - a. BVM ventilations
  - b. Insertion of a BLS airway adjunct
  - c. Insertion of Combitube
  - d. Intubation
  
2. Intraosseous infusion
  - a. EZ-IO drill
  - b. Set up and infuse a fluid bolus
  
3. Needle decompression
  - a. Locate and identify the landmarks for needle decompression
  - b. Demonstrate the skill on a manikin
  
4. Medicated infusion
  - a. Initiate an IV on a manikin
  - b. Mix Amiodarone, Procainamide, or 25% Dextrose (only one)
  - c. Set up, using the appropriate equipment, and administer the selected drug at the prescribed dosage/volume.
  
5. Surgical Airway Device
  - a. Describe the criteria for selecting this airway control method
  - b. Select proper equipment (Pertrach or Quicktach)
  - c. Locate landmarks
  - d. Demonstrate insertion of the device according to Region Six guidelines
  
6. Impedance Threshold Device
  - a. Describe the criteria for use of the ITD
  - b. Demonstrate the use of the ITD
  
7. Demonstrate correct 12-lead ECG placement.
